

PRESS CREDENTIALS AND PRESS ROOM TIMETABLE

Now the processing of the press credentials is finished, the Press Department of the ACPA and the Rally Príncipe de Asturias wishes to advise that individual emails have been sent either accepting or declining the forms, so all the professionals and media that applied should have received their email today.

There will be more than 100 media representatives from all over Spain as well as several European areas who have been accredited to inform about the event, valid for the European, Spanish and Asturian championships, which will be held on the 14th and 15th of September on the roads of a number of Asturian municipalities.

To help the accredited media, the organisers will put at their disposal a complete press room on the ground floor room of the Príncipe Felipe Auditorium, in Oviedo, this will also be the location to receive the press credentials. This press room will be the only one for this rally and the opening hours will be as follows:

- Thursday, 13th September, from 16:00 to 20:00 hours.
- Friday, 14th September, from 10:00 to 14:00 and from 15:00 to 0:00 hours.
- Saturday, 15th September, from 08:30 to 21:00 hours.

At the Service Park, held this year on the Parking area of the Carlos Tartiere Stadium in Oviedo, there will be, throughout the rally, an information point for drivers, teams, press and VIPs where they can see the stage times and general information about the event. All this information will also be published on the official website of the rally: www.rallyprincipe.com and the usual social media, Twitter and Facebook, will also be employed..

The Press Department would like to remind everyone that the press credentials are given to allow professionals to work at the event but they don't allow any additional privileges apart from access to some areas specifically reserved for the media, the use of the information

distributed about the event throughout its running and the use of the press room, with the resources available, for the media to do carry out their task.

The information from the organizers, the safety cars and the police require mandatory observance at all times in order to keep the rally safe. We should all set an example because the messages sent to the spectators aren't always enough and we must always remember that rallying is a dangerous sport.

The photographers must wear the official accreditation and also a jacket with the FOTO TV / PHOTO TV symbol to increase their visibility. For this purpose, the jackets provided by the Spanish Motorsport Federation are valid. In case of not having one of these, the organiser of the 49th Rally Príncipe de Asturias can provide the necessary jackets to the professional that require it against a deposit of 10 euros that will be refunded once the jacket is returned in good condition

The Press Department is at the disposal of the media, we are here to help you, as far as possible, to do your work. Have a good rally!
